

Dear parents and carers,

As we come to the end of another fantastic academic year, I wanted to take a moment to share some wonderful news and to thank you for the part you have played in helping our children achieve such incredible success.

I am absolutely delighted to tell you that this year, Bovey Tracey Academy has achieved the best SATs results in the school's history.

An incredible 95% of our year 6 pupils met the expected standard in reading, writing and maths, an increase of 27 percentage points on last year's results and significantly above the national average of 63%. We are equally proud that 75% of our pupils eligible for pupil premium funding and 75% of our pupils with special educational needs also achieved the expected standard across all three subjects. These outcomes reflect our commitment to ensuring every child can thrive and succeed.

There were many other achievements to celebrate across the school too:

- 97% of pupils reached the expected standard in both reading and mathematics, compared with a national average of 75%.
- 95% achieved the expected standard in writing, compared with 73% nationally.
- 94% of our Year 1 pupils passed the Phonics Screening Check.
- 87% of our Year 4 pupils achieved the expected standard in the Multiplication Tables Check, an increase of 26 percentage points on last year.
- Our Early Years Foundation Stage achieved an outstanding 94% Good Level of Development, up from 74% in 2025.

These results are something our whole school community should be incredibly proud of. They reflect the determination and enthusiasm of our children, the expertise and dedication of our staff, and the invaluable support you provide as families every single day.

While these outcomes are exceptional, they represent far more than test results. They are the result of children developing a love of reading, growing in confidence, becoming thoughtful mathematicians and curious learners, and building the knowledge and skills they will carry with them into the future.

Thank you for everything you do to support our school. It is a privilege to work in partnership with you, and together we are ensuring that every child has the opportunity to flourish.

We look forward to welcoming you and your children back to school on Friday 4th September. The first day back is very important as the staff have planned for this transition back into school to provide predictability and certainty on their first day back.
