Week Beginning 28th September 2026 and Events for Year 1 and 2

Maths

Both year 1 and 2 will be starting a new teaching sequence on Addition and Subtraction. We will be looking at number bonds within 10 and 20, and their related facts. Year 2 children will move on to bonds to 100.

Number Sense Year 1

We will be consolidating our understanding of subitising which we have focused on over the past 3 weeks. Children will be recapping on the representations we have used including the 10s frames, making up stories to represent images. We will be plugging any gaps they have in their understanding.

Number Sense Year 2

We will be looking at representations of one more and one less using number lines and 10s frames. We will be developing understanding that when we add one we get to the next counting number and when we subtract one, we get the previous counting number, e.g $5 - 1 = 4$.

Homework

Reading

Children will bring home two reading books. One is the book they have been reading in their RWInc group, allowing them to celebrate and build confidence in their reading. The second book focuses on the sounds and words they are learning and supports their progress.

Reading these books several times helps to improve accuracy, fluency and confidence. If you're short of time, a quick way to help is to practise the red and green words in the book and see how quickly your child can read them.

Please ensure that reading books are brought back to school every day for RWInc lessons.

Maths

We will have a weekly arithmetic test every Friday. Please support your child by helping them practise and become fluent with the number facts they are learning in our Number Sense sessions. If you would like to do a little extra at home, practising number bonds and facts to 10 and 20 will be very beneficial

Number Sense – Year 1

Guess How Many – Lay out between 1 and 10 items in a random arrangement. Guess how many there are. Then move the items onto a tens frame. (You can draw one of these on a piece of paper, it is a rectangle split into 2 rows with 5 columns.. See below) See if their guess was a good one.



Number Sense – Year 2

Look at some of your child's toys, such as little figures, small cars. Ask your child to get you some figures/cars, and tell them you want one more than 10. (don't give them the number, encourage them to understand the language of one more or one less than).
